#### **PRINCIPAL'S ADDRESS:**

Problem solving comes in many forms; not just in a Math book. Here is a problem from this morning:

Four grade 4 students were tasked with bringing in 12 boxes of different sizes and weights from Mr. J's car. The boxes were to be taken to room 21. To help, Mr. J drove to the nearest door.

To an adult this does not sound like much of a problem. But there was a lot of learning for our kids. First I chose one student as foreman. The foreman needed to choose his three helpers. That was interesting to watch. In moving the boxes, the lighter ones were easy but collaborating on the heavier boxes required a little team work. How do you carry a box with a partner? Is the weight shared equally and sliding them on the ground was discouraged as it scuffs up the floors? We even have a work crew member goofing off a little while others were working. A common life lesson.

It was great to see the students solving these problems and working out their issues. It's a great reminder that there are many life lessons waiting for our children if we just give them the chance and that not all learning comes from a book.
