Re: Parking on Rudyard Road – Bylaw Enforcement Campaign regarding illegal Parking on road.

The Town of View Royal Bylaw Enforcement Department has been fielding complaints regarding people blocking driveways along Rudyard Road during peak drop off/pick up times during the week. This practice currently contravenes the Streets Bylaw No. 980, 2019

SECTION 8: PARKING REGULATIONS

General Prohibitions for Stopping or Parking

8.1. Except when necessary to avoid conflict with traffic or to comply with the directions of a police officer or Traffic Control Device, or when allowed by signage or Permit, a driver or Owner of a vehicle must not park a vehicle:

8.1.4. in front of a Driveway Crossing or, where no Driveway Crossing flare exists, within one (1.0) metre of each side of a Driveway Crossing;

Although this vehicle congestion poses a major inconvenience to the people residing in the immediate area, it can also create a significant "risk to public safety' to all residents of the road during these peak times.

Therefore, Bylaw will be conducting active enforcement in the area, however, respectfully request this letter be disseminated via any School '**Newsletters**' to educate parents using the road. Hopefully this effort will mitigate the requirement to issue monetary penalties to those parents who continue to violate the Bylaw when dropping off/picking up their children who are attending the school.

We look forward to your cooperation and support in our request to ensure a safe pick up and drop off experience for students, parents and residents.

- 2. Go to MY ACCOUNT.
- 3. From the drop down menu, select My Students.
- 4. Click to add a student.
 - a. Type in your School Board Name
 - b. Select School Name from the list.
 - c. Enter Student Criteria (as set by your School Board)
 - d. CONFIRM

You can add up to 8 students on your profile

How to Make a Payment

- 1. You will be able to view any available items attached to your students that are set up on your account.
- 2. Select the item that you would like to purchase and click "add to Cart".

3. Once you have finished adding items to your cart, select "Check Out" to make payment. You can pay for multiple student's items in one Check Out.
